Diamond Blackfan Anaemia Syndrome (DBAS) is a rare bone marrow failure disorder usually diagnosed before 12 months of age but can present in later life. DBAS patients fail to produce red blood cells properly and will need treatment ranging from monthly blood transfusions to regular steroid treatment, and in some cases bone marrow transplant.
